TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Walter H. Lawson assignee of Mortgage from Edgar L. Burdette and Lucy B. Burdette, his wife, respectfully represents:

1. That on the 22nd day of June 1924 Edgar L. Burdette and Lucy B. Burdette, his wife, conveyed to ~~Walter H. Lawson~~ *Walter H. Lawson*, by way of Mortgage, all those three lots of land containing in the aggregate Twenty Eight acres more or less fronting on the Western side of the state road known as Route 240 at the Northern end of Hyattstown in Frederick County, Maryland and described in the three deeds following:

(a) From Edgar H. McBride dated on the 2nd day of June 1922, and recorded in liber # 340 at folio 38 one of the land records of said Frederick County.

(b) From Bradley W. Dutrow and wife, dated the 27th day of October 1915, and recorded in liber # 316 at folio 512, one of the land records of said Frederick County.

(c) From George A. Pearre Jr. and J. Clinton Mc Sherry, trustee, dated the 27th day of September 1919, and recorded in liber # 350 at folio 107, one of the land records of said Frederick County, to secure the repayment to her of the sum of \$3800.00; which said mortgage was duly assigned to your Petitioner as appeared from reference a certified copy of said mortgage duly recorded in liber # 349 at folio 80, one of the land
