erick County, as a Court of Equity:-

The Bill of Complaint of William S. Stoner and Martha A.  
Stoner, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

- 1st. That a certain John W. Stoner departed this life, intes-  
tate, in, or about, the year 1860 seized and possessed of  
a farm, containing forty-five acres, two roods and fourteen  
square perches of land, more or less, situated in Frederick  
County in the State of Maryland, which is fully described  
in a deed from William Diehl to said John W. Stoner bearing  
date on the first day of March A.D. 1858 and recorded in Li-  
ber E.G.F. No. 1 folio 601 etc. one of the Land Records of  
Frederick County, a certified copy of which deed is filed  
herewith as part hereof, marked Exhibit No. 1.
- 2nd. That said John W. Stoner left surviving him a widow, Mary  
Stoner, who died in the month of September A.D. 1906, and  
the following children and descendants, as his heirs at law,  
to whom the above mentioned real estate descended subject to  
the dower of his said widow, which dower is now extinguished  
by reason of the death of the widow, viz.:
