TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Lola M. Summers respectfully represents:

1. That a certain Bertie Forrest, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was, at the time of her death, seized and possessed of an undivided one-ninth (1/9) interest in and to all of the following described real estate located in Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit:

(1) All that lot of land containing fifteen (15) acres, more or less, described in the deed to her and others, from John W. Younkens and wife, by deed dated November 19, 1920, and recorded in Liber 376 at folio 17, one of the Land Records for said Frederick County, and a Certified Copy of said deed is filed herewith as part of this bill of complaint and marked Exhibit "A".

(2) All that lot of Mountain Land containing five (5) acres, one (1) rood and twenty-seven (27) square perches, more or less, being the same real estate described in the deed from D. B. D. Smeltzer to the said John W. Younkens, who departed

one of said land records, certified copy filed + marked "Exhibit B"
