

The Defendants in the above entitled cause having been duly warned to appear and to answer said Bill of Complaint filed against them, and having failed to appear and answer said Bill of Complaint, according to the exigencies of the Writ of Summons and the said Order of Publication duly passed and published against them in said cause,

It is thereupon this 2nd day of July, 1941, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, adjudged, ordered and decreed that the Complainants are entitled to relief in the premises, and that the Bill of Complaint be and is hereby taken pro confesso against the said defendants Charles O. all adults; but because it does not certainly appear to what relief the Complainants are entitled, it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed, by the authority aforesaid, that the Complainants take testimony before any one of the Examiners of this Court, to support the allegations of their Bill of Complaint.
