

1. That this Honorable Court will construe the Will of James H. Cramer, and particularly the ~~fourth~~^{seventh} paragraph thereof, to determine whether a trust was thereby created.

2. That, if the Court should decide that a trust was created, the Court will then assume jurisdiction of that portion of the trust estate consisting of the undivided one-fourth interest in the two North Street lots; and that the Court will decree a private sale thereof if it should appear to the Court to be advantageous to the parties concerned.

3. That, if the Court should decide that no trust was created, the Court will decree a private sale of the interest of Alice Cramer Bohman in the two North Street lots if such a sale should appear to the Court to be for the benefit and advantage of Alice Cramer Bohman.

4. And for such other and further relief as the nature of your Petitioners' case may require.
