PETITION AND REPORT OF SALES

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sales of Gail L. Cutshall, Committee of Julia Etta Davis, Incompetent appointed by decree of this Court, passed on the 21st day of October, 1959, to make sale of the interest of the incompetent of the real and personal property of said incompetent, being an interest as tenant by the entirety with the husband of said incompetent, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That your Petitioner gave bond with security for the faithful performance of his trust, and complied with all the other prerequisites, as required by law and the said decree.
