TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Report and Account of Charles McC. Mathias, co-trustee under the Will of Grace W. Trail, deceased, for the use and benefit of Grace Trail Babcock, covering the administration of the trust estate in the hands of Charles McC. Mathias and Charles B. Trail, Trustees, from January 6, 1952 to November 22, 1955, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1. That as hereinbefore reported, your Honorable Court assumed jurisdiction of the trust created by the Last Will and Testament of Grace W. Trail, deceased, for the use and benefit of her daughter, Grace Trail Babcock, by an Order passed on the 27th day of January 1943, and therein fixed the bond to be given by the said Trustees for the faithful performance of their duties as Trustees in the sum of \$10,000.00.

2. That the said Trustees furnished bond in the amount prescribed by said Order, with Globe Indemnity Company, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, as surety thereon, which said bond still continues in force.

3. That since the filing of the Trustees' Seventh Report under date of February 28, 1952, there has been a consolidation of the Farmers and Mechanics National Bank and The Citizens National Bank of Frederick; that as a result of said consolidation the said Trustees now have 300 shares of Farmers and Mechanics-Citizens National Bank stock in lieu of the 50 shares of Farmers and Mechanics National Bank stock heretofore reported and that the said Trustees have received to date from the liquidating committee of The Citizens National Bank of Frederick \$3900.00 in cash in lieu of 30 shares of
