Whereas, such notice by publication was given warning all parties in interest to appear and show cause, if any, why a decree should not be passed as prayed on or before December 31, 1955, as evidenced by the annexed Certificate of Publication, which is marked "Exhibit A", and

WHEREAS, no party in interest has appeared to object to the said resignation of Charles McC. Mathias as said trustee, and

Whereas, by Order of Your Honorable Court dated the 18th day of January, 1956, Charles B. Trail was removed and discharged as trustee under the Will of Grace W. Trail, deceased, and

Whereas, by virtue of the said resignation of Charles McC. Mathias and removal of Charles B. Trail, there is now no trustee in the within cause.
