


EIGHTH: That by reason of the mental disability of the said Grace Trail Babcock, as hereinbefore alleged, the said Grace Trail Babcock is incompetent to appear and answer the proceedings herein instituted and referred to, and that it is desirable that Trustees may be appointed by your Honorable Court to answer for her and represent her interests in said partition proceedings in No. 15215 Equity, hereinbefore referred to.


WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honors to pass a decree in this Honorable Court appointing a Trustee or Trustees to file an Answer for the said Grace Trail Babcock in said partition proceedings hereinbefore referred to, and to further represent her in said proceedings as to them shall appear to be to her best interest.

Reference is hereby made especially in the prayer of this petition, to Chapter 480 of the Acts of 1943 of the General Assembly of Maryland, which statute amends by repealing and re-enacting Section 125 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 edition).

MAY it please your Honors to grant unto the petitioners Writ of Subpoena, directed to the said Grace Trail Babcock, a resident of Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland, commanding her to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named therein, and to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
