



ORDER OF COURT

The foregoing Petition and Affidavit having been by the Court read and considered, it is thereupon this 23rd day of February, 1950, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ordered, adjudged, and decreed that Charles McC. Mathias and the Farmers and Mechanics National Bank of Frederick, Trustees, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to take charge of and manage the undivided one-fifth interest of the said Grace Trail Babcock in and to the farm referred to in the foregoing Petition, and to sell and convey unto the State Roads Commission of Maryland the interest of the said Grace Trail Babcock in and to the 11.59 acres of land upon payment to them of the proportionate share of the purchase price referred to in said Petition, accruing to the said Grace Trail Babcock, and to hold said fund subject to the further order of this Court.
