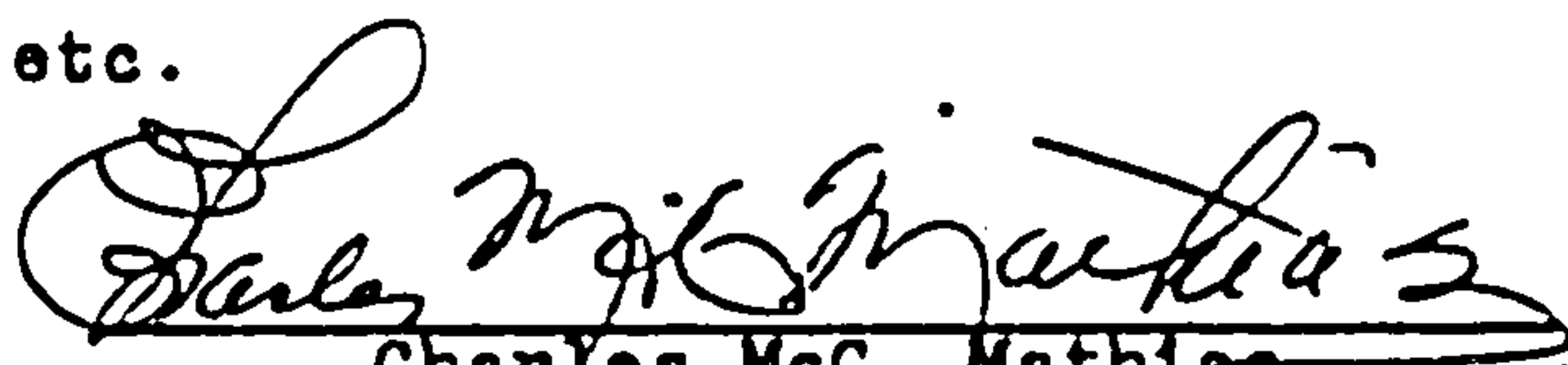


construction of a 34.5 KV power line along the border of a 13-acre field which lies on the Western margin of the new U. S. Route 240 and have agreed to pay to the owners of the farm hereinbefore described the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the grant of a right-of-way along the Eastern border of said 13-acre field said right-of-way to involve the erection of eight poles together with the right to enter on said land for the construction and maintenance of a power line as aforesaid.

4. That your Petitioners are advised that it is to the benefit, advantage and best interest of the said Grace Trail Babcock, the incompetent referred to herein, that your Petitioners conclude said arrangement with the Potomac Edison Company and convey unto said Potomac Edison Company her interest in the land subject to the proposed power line as hereinbefore described and to hold her proportionate share of the purchase price subject to the further order of your Honorable Court.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that they may be authorized and directed to join with other interests in conveying unto the Potomac Edison Company the interest of their cestui que trust in and to a 50-foot right-of-way for the construction of a power line over that portion of the farm herein mentioned and described and over which said power line will be constructed, upon payment by the Potomac Edison Company of the stipulated sum hereinbefore referred to and to hold a proportionate share of Grace Trail Babcock in said purchase price subject to the further order of the Court.
