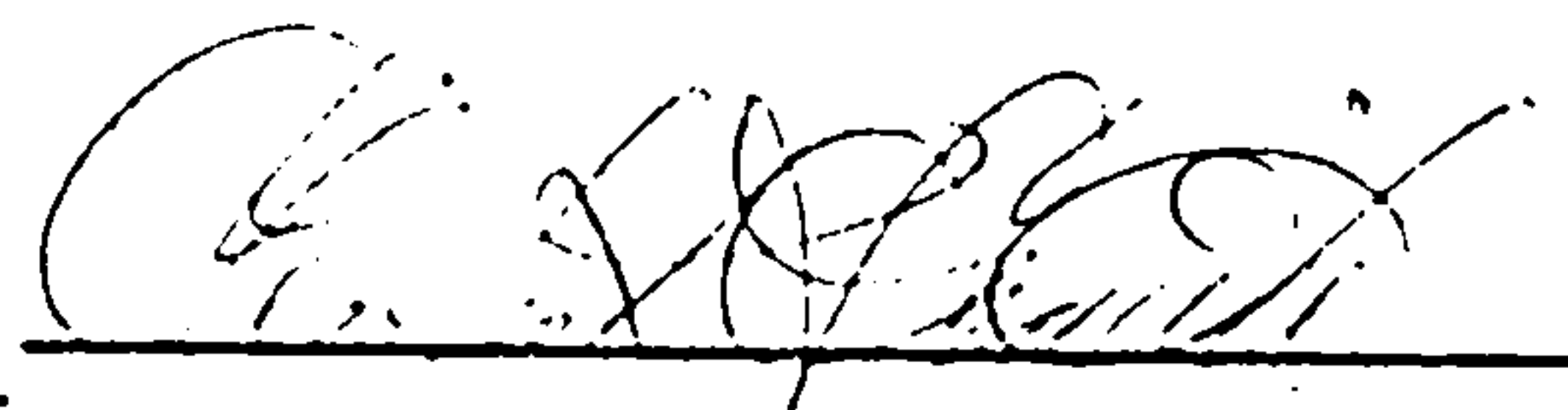


STATE OF MARYLAND, FREDERICK COUNTY, TO-WIT:

ORDER OF COURT

The foregoing Petition and Affidavit, having been by the Court read and considered, it is thereupon this 23rd day of June, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ordered, adjudged and decreed that Charles McC.
