

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That your Honorable Court will pass an Order directing the standing Auditor of the Court to make an allowance of five (5%) per cent on the purchase price of the real estate referred to in this proceeding to Gordon W. Spurrier.

2. That the said Auditor shall make an allowance of One Hundred Eighty (\$180.00) Dollars to the lending institution, Farmers and Mechanics-Citizens National Bank, financing the property for the purchaser under the provisions of the Federal Housing Administration Law.
