

fair distribution of the proceeds of the sale of the said property and are therefore incapable of making a distribution of the said property among themselves.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

(1) That a partition of the said real estate may be made among the aforesaid children of Edgar Allen Valentine, deceased, according to their several just proportions, agreeably to the Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided.

(2) That this Honorable Court appoint a Trustee or Trustees to sell the said property, either at private or public sale, in such a manner as will be most advantageous and produce the highest possible price obtainable, which will be to the benefit of all of the said respective children of Edgar Allen Valentine, deceased.

(3) That all of the children of Edgar Allen Valentine, deceased, except those complaining, be required to file their Answer under Affidavit.

(4) That your Petitioners may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.

May it please the Court, cause process to be served against all of the Children of Edgar Allen Valentine, except those complaining.
