

ants and although the Complainants claim to hold a valid fee simple title, the same cannot be established of record without the removal of the aforesaid clouds upon the title of the Complainants; that the Complainants are willing to pay such collateral inheritance tax as may be found to be due upon the property in order to assist in removing such cloud,

It is thereupon this 11th day of October, 1960, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ORDERED that the Complainants, by causing a copy of this Order to be inserted in some newspaper published in said Frederick County, once a week in each of four successive weeks, the last of such publications to be made not less than thirty days before the 15th day of December, 1960, give notice to the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Henry N. Waters, deceased, Minnie J. Waters, widow, and Charles Waters and Isabella Waters, his wife, whether residents or non-residents, of the object and substance of this Bill, warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the 15th day of December, 1960, next, to show cause, if any they have, why a Decree ought not to be passed as prayed.
