

DECREE PRO CONFESSO

It appearing from the proceedings in this cause that the Order of Publication heretofore issued therein has been duly published in The Valley Register, a newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, as prescribed by said order and that none of the defendants or possible defendants have appeared, either in person or by solicitor, nor answered the Bill of Complaint therein filed against them nor showed cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed.
