MRS. ODA B. FILLER, a witness for the Complainants, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

By Mr. Clapp:

Q Will you give the Court your full name?

A Oda Burrier Filler.

Q Where do you live? A. With him.

Q With your brother? A. Yes.

Q And how long have you known this property of Mr. and Mrs. Waters?

A Well, I was born and raised there the same place he was, right next to them.

Q Did you ever know the Waters family?

A I didn't know them. I don't remember them. I know they lived there, and we never had any occasion to go there and I don't know anything about them.

Q Do you know whether they had any children?

A I don't know.

Q Did you ever see any children around the place?

A No, I don't know anything about his family.

Q Would you say Mr. Waters died over twenty years ago?

A Oh yes, it's been more than 20 years since they have lived.

Q Since that time do you recall who might have lived on the place?

A Well, I don't recall much who lived there. After the Stevens bought it they only lived there - they built a house on the corner after they had it and Roger Ramsburg's son, Albert Ramsburg, lived there a while.
