WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), in current money, and other good and valuable considerations, this date paid unto me by The FrederickTown Savings Institution, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, in Frederick County, at and before the execution and delivery of this Deed, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Lewis E. Owens, do hereby grant and convey unto the said The FrederickTown Savings Institution, all that tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in New Market District, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, being the same real estate as described in the Deed from Jesse Engle and Sarah Engle, his wife, to John Engle, dated May 1st, 1834, and recorded in Liber J. S. No. 46, folios 135 and 136, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, and being the same real estate as described in the Deed from Nicholas H. Pitts, Trustee, to Philip Mussetter, dated August 26th, in the year 1848, and recorded in Liber W.B.T. No. 7, folio 517, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland;-and being the same real estate as described in the Deed from Jacob Rohrbach, Trustee in No. 9011 Equity, to Mary J. Owens and Sarah A.
