TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY,
MARYLAND, SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY.

The Bill of Complaint of Cyrus A. Hays and Cora D. Hays, his
wife, and Mollie M. Minnick and James P. Minnick, her husband, re-
spectfully shows:

1. That Herman Homer Hays, a resident of Frederick
County, Maryland, departed this life intestate on January 30, 1947,
seised and possessed of a parcel of real estate containing thirty-
two acres of land, more or less, with improvements thereon consist-
ing of a dwelling house and other outbuildings, situated in Catootin
District, Frederick County, Maryland, which said parcel of real
estate was conveyed unto the said Herman Homer Hays, in fee simple,
by deed from Cyrus A. Hays and others dated January 11, 1926 and
recorded in Liber 358, folio 29, one of the land records of Fred-
erick County, Maryland. A certified copy of said deed is filed
herewith and marked "Plaintiffs' Exhibit No. 1" and prayed to be
considered as part hereof.

2. That the said Herman Homer Hays left surviving him
the following heirs-at-law: Cyrus A. Hays, a brother, who resides
near Garfield, Frederick County, Maryland, and whose wife's name is
Cora D. Hays; Mollie M. Minnick, a sister, who resides near Reid,
Washington County, Maryland, and whose husband's name is James P.
Minnick; John O. Hays, a brother, who resides at 467 East Green
