Storm, at public auction at the Court House door, Frederick, Maryland, for the sum of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) a tract or parcel of land located in Linganore District, Frederick County, Maryland, consisting of five acres more or less of real estate assessed in the name of Joseph Loveth on account of State and County taxes then due and in arrears.
