Joseph Loveth, his heirs at law and next of kin, and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in a parcel of five (5) acres of land, more or less, situate in Linganore District and assessed on the Tax Records of Frederick County, Maryland in the name of Joseph Loveth, and James H. Falk, County Treasurer for Frederick County, and Wilhelmina Loveth, record owner, her heirs at law and next of kin, and all unknown owners or claimants to any interest in said property, Defendants.

The object of this proceeding is to secure the foreclosure of all rights of redemption in the following property: all that real estate as conveyed to Wilhelmina Loveth, wife of Joseph Loveth, Brom Wilhelmina Steinburg and France Steinberg, also known as Franz Steinberg, her husband, by deed dated March 3, 1908 and recorded in Liber No. 282, Folio 222, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, which land is described on the tax rolls of Frederick County as five acres and assessed in the name of Joseph Loveth, 13 North Wolfe Street, Baltimore, Maryland and being the same real estate as sold by the County Treasurer and Collector of Taxes for the County of Frederick and State of Maryland agent for the to the/plaintiff in this proceeding.

The Bill of Complaint states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

IN IS THEREUPON THIS 11th ^{*October*} day of ~~September~~, 1957, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, ORDERED, That notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this ORDER in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks, warning all persons interested ^{said} in the ~~xxxx~~ property to be and appear in this Court by the 14th day of *December*, 1957, and redeem the property referred to and described herein and Answer the Bill, or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, and vesting in the Plaintiff a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
