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FINAL DECREE

This cause being submitted and the proceedings and papers herein having been duly read and considered by the Court, it is thereupon this 2nd day of January, 1958, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in Equity, and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that all rights of redemption of all of the Defendants, James H. Falk, Collector of Taxes for Frederick County, Wilhelmina Loveth, record owner, her heirs at law and next of kin, Joseph Loveth, his heirs at law and next of kin, and all unknown owners or claimants to any interest in the property described on the tax rolls of Frederick County as five (5) acres of land in Linganore District, assessed in the name of Joseph Loveth and all persons having or claiming to have any interest in said land, be and they are hereby foreclosed from all rights of redemption in said property and that James H. Falk, County Treasurer and Tax Collector of Frederick County, be and he is hereby directed to execute a deed in fee simple to Mildred R. Storm, the Complainant in these proceedings, and the holder of the certificate of sale, upon payment to the said James H. Falk, County Treasurer, of the balance of the purchase price of the property, together with all taxes, interest and penalties thereon accruing subsequent to April 9, 1956, and it is further ORDERED that a certified copy of this Decree be served upon James H. Falk, County Treasurer and Tax Collector for Frederick County, Maryland.
