Sixth - I give and bequeath unto my grandson, Robert Franklin Davis, my 1940 Oldsmobile and I direct that this automobile be kept for the use and benefit of my husband, Bernard C. Gross, as long as he shall desire use of it, or until he re-marry.

Seventh - I give and bequeath unto Bernard C. Gross, my husband, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Eighth - I give and bequeath unto my daughters, Lilly Scott and Rosie Davis each, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Ninth - I give and bequeath unto my granddaughter, Winifred Burns, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

Tenth - I give and bequeath unto my grandson, Robert Franklin Davis, IN TRUST, my cedar chest and all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, either real, or personal, and including all monies I may have on deposit in the Peoples National Bank in Brunswick, The Citizens National Bank, Frederick, Maryland, or in any other bank or banks. I direct that my home at 907 East C Street, Brunswick, be retained and a home provided therein for my husband, Bernard C. Gross, as long as he shall live, or until his remarriage. Should he remarry, I direct that this life tenancy shall cease and that all privileges of my said husband shall cease.

Eleventh - I hereby appoint my said husband, Bernard C. Gross, Trustee for my grandson, Robert Franklin Davis, until he becomes twenty-one years of age. On his 21st birthday, I direct that this trusteeship shall end and that payment be made to said grandson.
