TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR
FREDERICK COUNTY, SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY:

The Petition of Robert Franklin Davis, infant, by Rosie Barncord, his mother, respectfully represents to your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That the said Robert Franklin Davis, infant, one of the defendants in the above entitled cause, was returned served in this proceeding by the Sheriff of Baltimore County under date of September 2, 1953, but the said return of the Sheriff did not show that a copy of the subpoena and bill of complaint had been left with the said Rosie Barncord, the mother of the said infant, with whom he resided. That subsequently the return of the said Sheriff was amended to show that a copy of the subpoena and bill of complaint had been left with the said Rosie Barncord, the mother of the said infant.

SECOND: That the said defendant, Robert Franklin Davis, being an infant under the age of twenty-one years, can not appear and answer for himself, and that he has no legal guardian within the jurisdiction of this Court; and although the guardian ad litem was appointed by your Honorable Court on the 18th day of September, 1953, upon the petition of the plaintiff in these proceedings, the said guardian was appointed before the amendment of the return of the Sheriff as aforesaid, and it now appears desirable for your Honorable Court to appoint again a guardian ad litem for the infant defendant after the return of the Sheriff has been amended.
