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- Q. Mr. Stine, is the H. Irving Stine mentioned in the deeds and mortgages that I have just introduced in evidence the same person as the Hiram Stine to whom you have referred?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Was his full name Hiram Irving Stine?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Mr. Stine, you are also Administrator of your brother's estate?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Is it your intention from the other assets to pay off the debts?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Mr. Stine, is this property susceptible of a division in kind among the heirs you named?
- A. No.
- Q. Can it be divided between the heirs without the loss and injury to them?
- A. No..
- Q. Is it to the benefit and advantage of all of the parties that the property be sold and proceeds be divided?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Is it to the interest and advantage of the infants that the property be sold and proceeds be divided?
- A. Yes.
- Q. What in your opinion is the fair market value of the property involved, Mr. Stine?
- A. Between \$35,000 and \$38,000.
