

an interest therein without loss or damage, and it would be to the benefit and advantage of the parties in interest that the same be sold and the proceeds therefrom be divided according to the interests of the respective parties.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

1. That a decree may be passed for the sale of the said Real Estate and the appoint of a Trustee or Trustees to sell the same.

2. That the proceeds of the said sale may be distributed between your Complainants and Defendants, according to their respective rights and interests.

3. That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as their cause may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena issued in the usual form directed to the said Defendants commanding them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named therein.

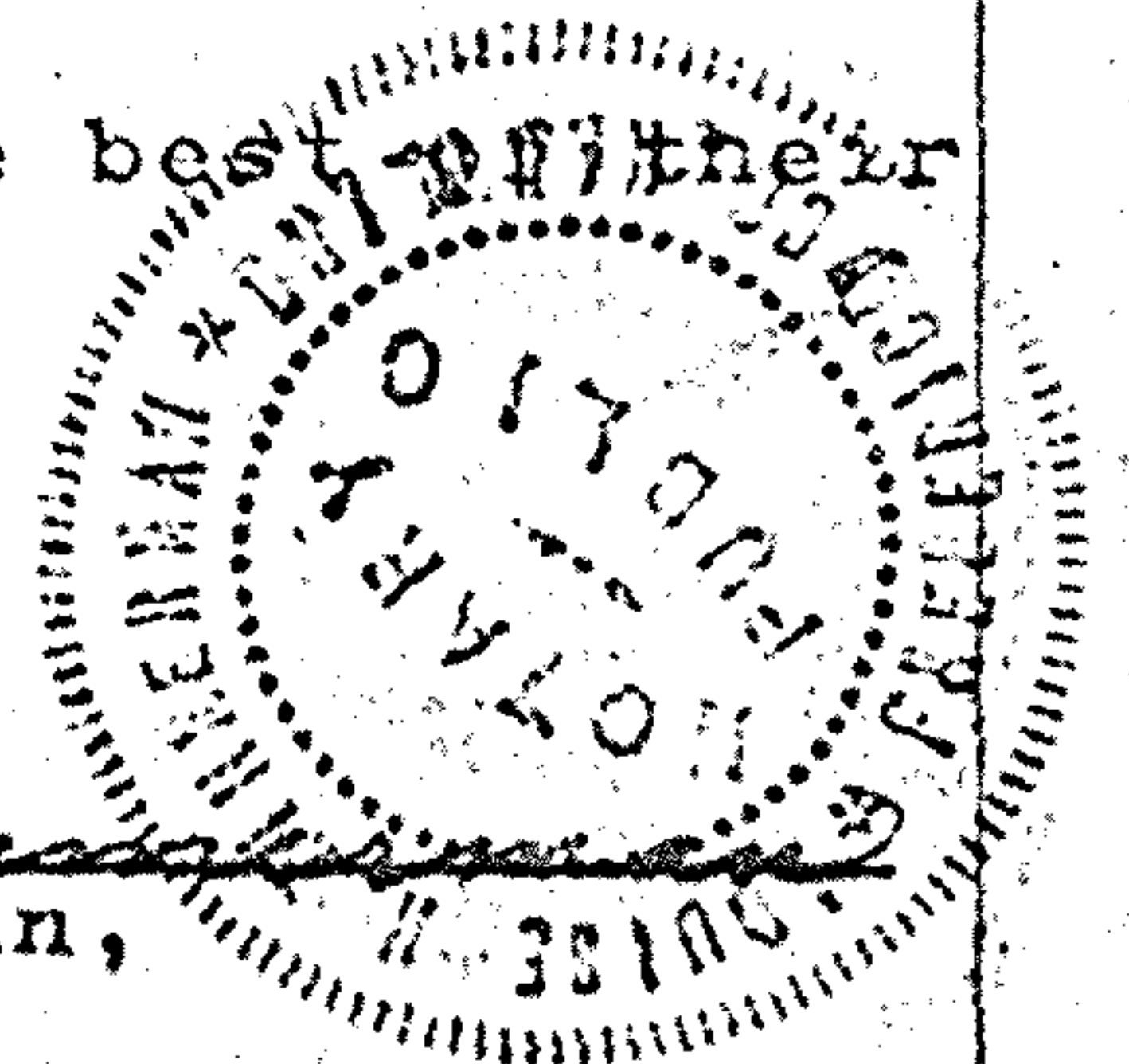
