PETITION AND REPORT OF SALE

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sale of Alton Y. Bennett and Stanley Y. Bennett, Trustees, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

FIRST: That on the 12th day of June, 1961, this Honorable Court ordered and decreed that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold at public sale and that your Petitioners be appointed Trustees to make the said sale.

SECOND: That acting pursuant to said Order and Decree, your Petitioners filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a Corporate Surety approved by the Clerk in the penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars.

THIRD: That your Petitioners advertised the said real estate in the Frederick News and Frederick Post, newspapers published in Frederick City and County, once a week for three successive weeks prior to the day of sale, as evidenced by Printer's Certificate filed herewith marked "Exhibit No. 1" with Report of Sale.
