TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of William G. Dixon, Hazel Dixon,
Martha Kehne, Dallas Kehne, Frances M. McLane, Frank McLane,
Ethel V. Smith and Richard Smith, respectfully represents:

1. That a certain Gideon A. Bussard was, at the time of
his death, seized and possessed of a certain farm in Urbana
District, in said Frederick County, Maryland, containing 157½
acres of land, more or less, and being described in the Deed
from Gideon Bussard and Ann S. Bussard, his wife, to said Gideon
A. Bussard, dated April 18, 1897, and recorded in Liber J.L.J.
16, at folio 227, one of the Land Records for said Frederick
County, and a certified copy of said Deed is filed herewith,
and marked "Exhibit A", as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

2. That being so seized and possessed of said real estate
the said Gideon A. Bussard departed this life intestate, on or
about the year 1898, and left surviving him, as his only heirs
