3. That said Adelle Dixon, departed this life intestate about the year 1935, seized and possessed of her undivided interest in said real estate and left surviving her as her only heirs at law, her surviving husband, Grover C. Dixon and the following children: William G. Dixon, husband of Hazel Dixon, Martha Kehne, wife of Dallas Kehne, Frances McLane, wife of Frank McLane and Ethel Smith, wife of Richard Smith, as her only heirs at law.

4. That said Bertha V. Bussard departed this life intestate on or about , 1947, seized and possessed of her undivided interest in said real estate and left surviving her as her only heirs at law, the above named Bertha Hoffman, Hamilton Bussard, Jesse Bussard and Mollie Anderson, and the above named children of Adelle and Grover C. Dixon.

5. That said real estate is not susceptible of division amongst the parties in interest, without loss and injury to the parties<sup>in</sup> interest in said real estate.

Wherefore, your complainants pray for the following relief:

1. That a Decree may be passed for said sale of said real estate.
2. That a Trustee or Trustees may be appointed to make said sale and distribution.
3. That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.

And may it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainant the Writ of Subpoena in the usual form for said defendants, all residents of Frederick County, Maryland.
