The Bill of Complaint of James Arunah Rogers and Kathleen R. Rogers, his wife, Thomas Hardey Rogers and Edith S. Rogers, his wife, Rosa Rogers Nicklas, divorced, Mary Elizabeth Fitzsimmons and William J. Fitzsimmons, her husband, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

First: That Charles Arunah Rogers, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was in his lifetime seized and possessed of a farm, or tract of land, with buildings and improvements thereon, containing two hundred and two acres, two roods and four square perches of land, situated in Buckeystown District, in Frederick County, Maryland, being part of a tract of land called "Rocky Fountain" and now known as "Eutaw Place", and being the same real estate described in a deed from Mary Abell Rogers et al. to the said Charles Arunah Rogers, dated May 28th. 1896, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 14, folio 182, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, a certified copy of which said deed is filed herewith, marked "Exhibit Deed" and prayed to be taken and considered as a part hereof.

Second: That the said Charles Arunah Rogers, while so seized and possessed of said real estate, died on the 20th. day of February, 1924, leaving a last will and testament duly executed to pass real and personal property in this State, dated December 16th. 1914, which was duly admitted to probate by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County February 25, 1924 and recorded in Liber G.E.S. No. 1, folio 240, one of the Will Records for Frederick County, a certified copy of which is herewith filed as a part hereof and marked "Exhibit Will".
