

as he shall expend in looking after the above mentioned estate to be deducted from said estate and acting in the capacity of such trustee I request that the said William J. Grove see to it that the casket in which I am buried does not exceed in cost the sum of Eighty \$80.00 Dollars in price; also using such hacks in addition thereto that may be needed for said funeral.

Eight I also devise the sum of Fifty Dollars per year to St Joseph Catholic Church as long as said Church is a local parish with a Pastor in charge and the said sum to be taken from above mentioned estate by the said William J. Grove as Trustee. Should said Parish ever be closed I hereby devise the necessary sums to keep the grave lots of myself & family as well as my parents in proper condition of repair. I also wish to be interred in same lot as is buried the bodies of my father & mother.

Ninth It is my desire that a small stone be placed on the grave in which I am buried said stone not to exceed 5 feet in height.

Tenth Such securities as I own are now in the possession of The Frick Company of Waynesboro as collateral and also in the Fredericktown Savings Institution and also in Box 68 of the Citizens National Bank both latter Institutions of Frederick City Md

Eleventh It is my desire that my Trustee take immediate possession of my traveling case after my death.
