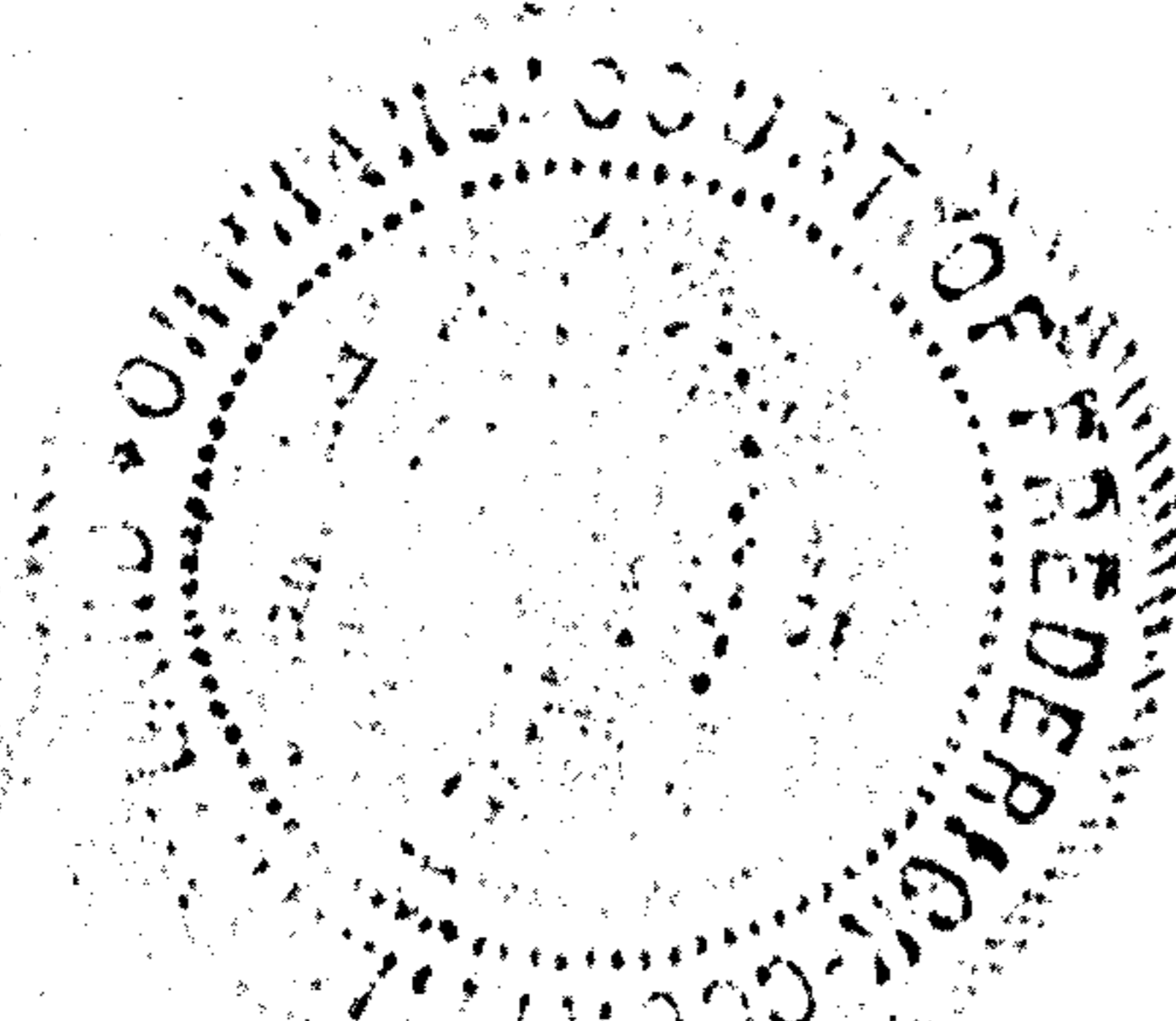


State of Maryland, Frederick County, Sct.

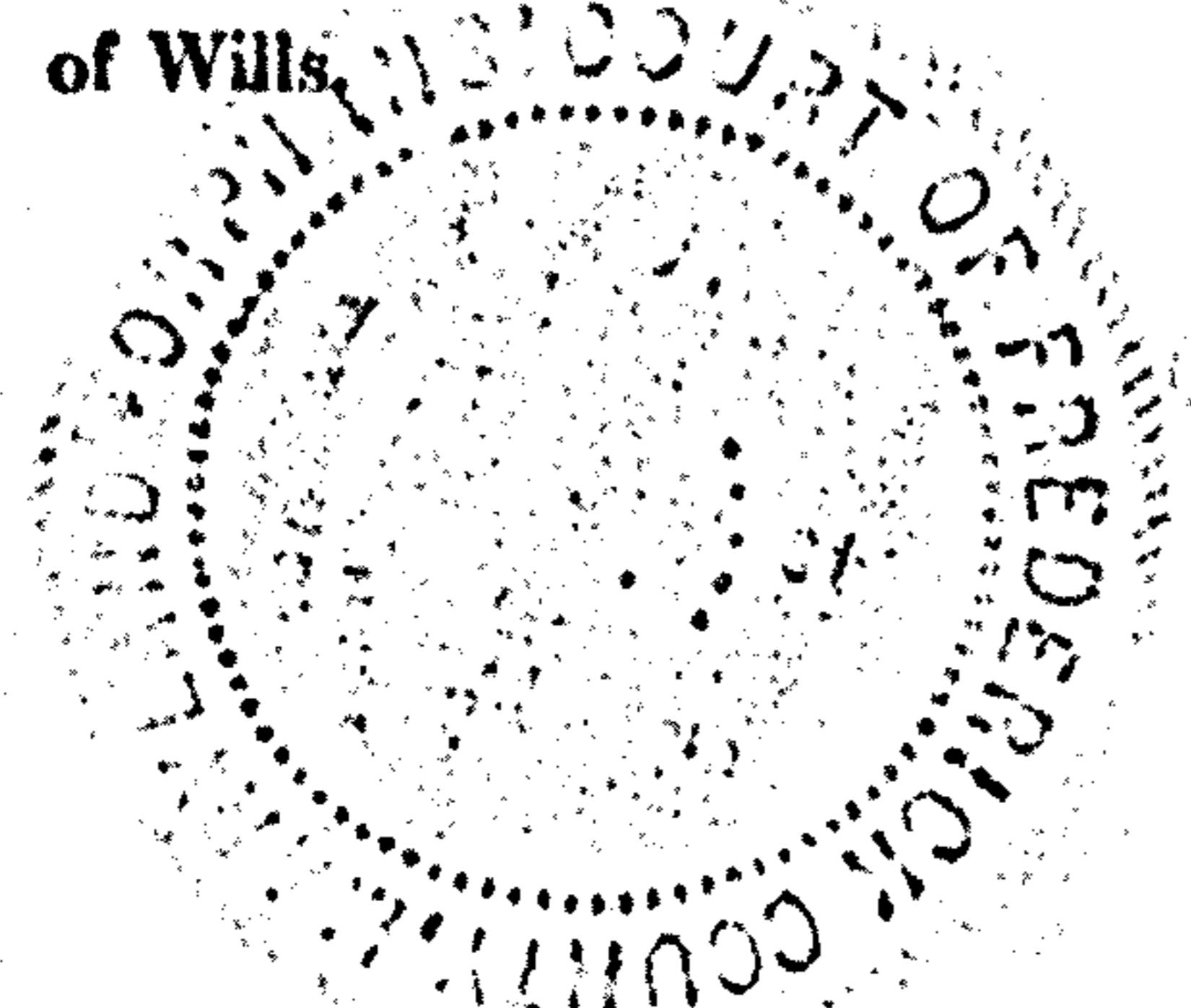

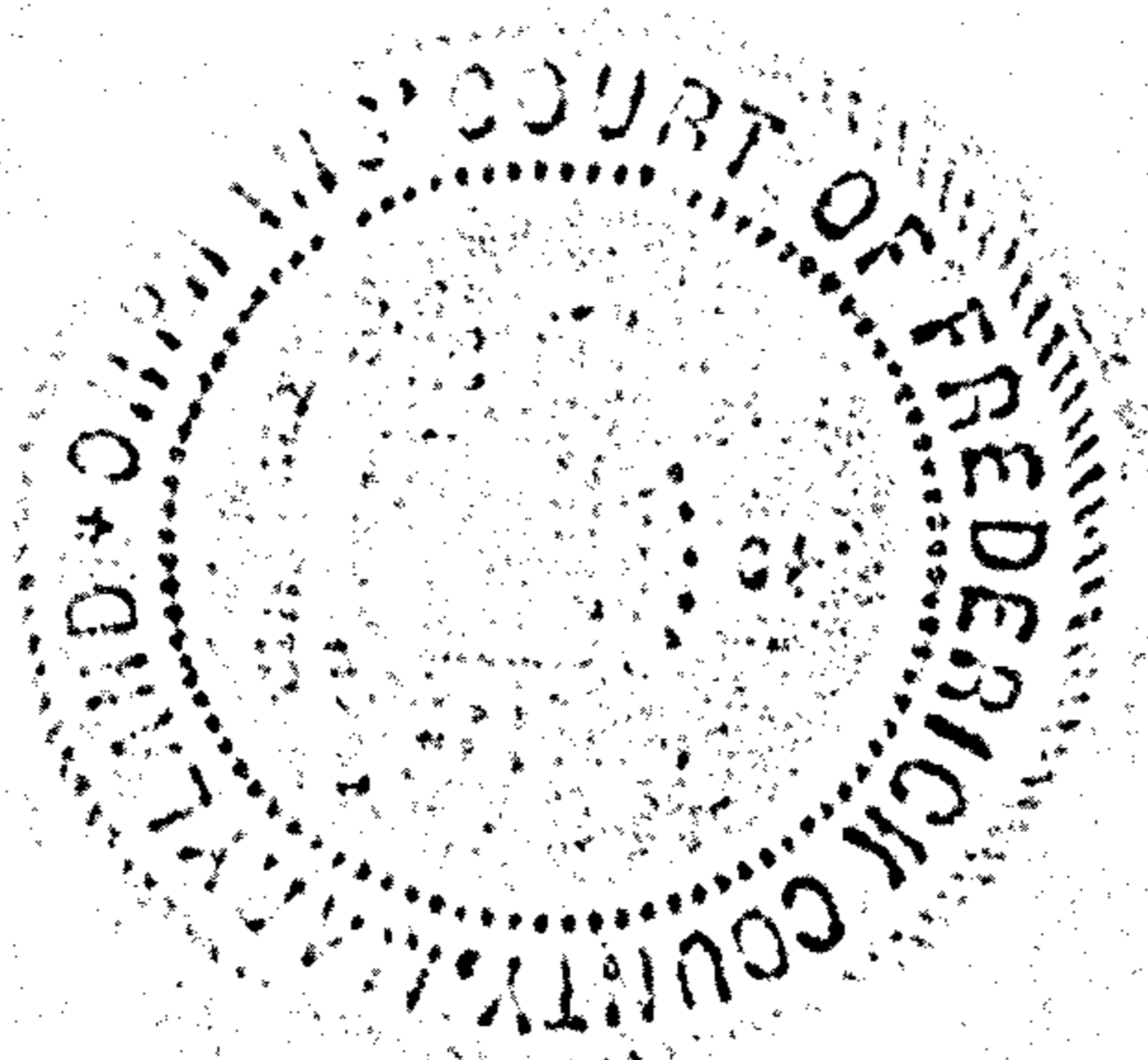
