

FOURTH: That your Petitioner alleges that the residue of the money represented from the sale of the real estate in these proceedings now in the hands of the Trustees should be applied to the debts claimed by your Petitioner and the claims of all the other creditors, if any, of the said Earl D. Harp, according to their respective rights and interests.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner prays that the residue of the money now in the hands of the Trustees in this cause, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be applied to the claims of your Petitioner and the claims of the other creditors of the said Earl D. Harp.

And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Petitioner the Writ of Subpoena in the usual form, directed against E. Austin James and Edwin F. Mikirk, Trustees, and Catherine E. Harp, Hubert H. Harp, infant, residing at Walkersville, Route 1, Frederick County, Maryland, and Elmer Harp, infant, residing at Walkersville, Route 1, Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such Decree as may be passed.
