TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Answer of Catherine E. Harp to the Creditors' Petition filed in the above entitled cause August 9, 1943, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That she admits the allegations contained in the first paragraph thereof.

SECOND: Answering the second paragraph thereof, your Respondent avers that her deceased husband, Earl D. Harp, owned considerable more personal property at the time of his death than was reported in the Administrators' proceedings in the Orphans' Court for Frederick County.

THIRD: That she denies her late husband at the time of his death was indebted to William K. Smith in the sum of Thirty-three Dollars and Ten Cents (\$33.10) as alleged in the third paragraph thereof.

FOURTH: Answering the fourth paragraph thereof, your Respondent avers that certain debts for claims filed against this estate by certain persons in the Orphans' Court are not genuine, and, therefore, should not be charged against the estate of the said Earl D. Harp, deceased.
