TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR  
FREDERICK COUNTY, SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY:

The Petition and report of Sale of Parsons Newman, assignee  
of a mortgage executed by George A. Strickler and Bessie May  
Strickler, his wife to The Real Estate and Improvement Company of  
Baltimore City, a body corporate, respectfully shows unto your  
Honors:

First: That on the Fourteenth day of October, in the  
year Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-Seven, George A. Strickler and  
Bessie May Strickler, his wife, being then indebted unto The Real  
Estate and Improvement Company of Baltimore City, a body corporate,  
in the sum of Six Hundred and Two Dollars and Six Cents (\$602.06),  
executed their deed of mortgage of said date to secure the payment  
of the said sum, together with interest thereon at the rate of six  
per centum per annum, in monthly installments of at least Twenty  
Dollars (\$20.00), including interest, beginning for the first  
installment thereof on the last day of October, Nineteen Hundred and  
Thirty-seven, whereby they conveyed unto the said The Real Estate  
and Improvement Company of Baltimore City, a body corporate, all  
those pieces or parcels of ground situate, lying and being in the  
town of Brunswick, Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and  
described as follows, that is to say:

Beginning at a point on the north side of "D" (formerly
