- Q. Will you state your full name, age and address, please.
- A. Charles K. Hill; age thirty-five; Knoxville, Maryland.
- Q. Did you know Amanda I. Brashears in her lifetime?
- A. No, sir. She died before I was born.
- Q. You are a son of Henry and Bessie Estella Hill?
- A. That is right.
- Q. When did your mother die?
- A. About four years ago.
- Q. Your father is still living?
- A. Yes.
- Q. You have other living brothers or sisters who were living at the time of the death of your mother?
- A. Yes, two brothers.
- Q. What are your brothers' names?

- Q. Are either of your brothers married?
- A. Henry Hill is, and his wife's name is Arbutus. Henry and his wife live at Brunswick, and Wilbur Alton Hill lives at Knoxville, Maryland. All are of age.
- Q. Do you have any living uncles on your mother's side?
- A. Yes.
- Q. What are their names?
- A. Ambrose L. Brashears and Theodore H. Brashears, Jr.
- Q. Are either of your uncles married?
- A. The wife of one is dead, and the other is not married.
- Q. They are both over twenty-one years of age?
- A. Yes, sir.
