TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition and Report of Sale of Edward A. Christmas, Assignee by mesne assignments of Charles A. Norwood, Mortgages of Ira E. Burrier and Minnie L. Burrier, his wife, of Frederick County, State of Maryland, respectfully shew unto your Honors:

(1) That the said Ira E. Burrier and Minnie L. Burrier, his wife, of Frederick County, State of Maryland, being originally indebted unto Charles A. Norwood in the sum of \$12,000, executed their promissory note in the amount of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000), payable unto the said Charles A. Norwood, or order, for said sum of money on the 1st day of April, 1925, with interest at the rate of 5½% per annum, payable semi-annually; and for the purpose of better securing the payment of said promissory note as hereinbefore described and set forth, they executed and delivered unto the said Charles A. Norwood a Deed of Mortgage creating and conveying unto him, the said Charles A. Norwood, all that tract or parcel of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon and also together with all the rights, ways, uses, privileges and appurtenances thereunto appertaining or in anywise belonging, consisting of all that farm containing 17½ acres 32 sq. perches, more or less, situate, lying and being in Walkersville (formerly Mt. Pleasant) Election District, in Frederick County, Maryland aforesaid, and being the same property more particularly described in a Deed from Scott Crowell unto the said Ira E.
