

Land Records of Frederick County, and of which the said Charles F. Knock died seized and possessed, leaving as his sole heirs-at-law the aforesaid Lewis H. Knock and C. Frederick Knock, the interest of C. Frederick Knock having been conveyed unto the said Lewis H. Knock and Pauline Z. Knock, his wife, by deed dated March 12, 1937, and recorded in Liber No. 406, folio 502, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, of which said mortgage a certified copy is filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit "No. 2", ^{it being recorded} and in said mortgage it is provided that it shall be void upon the payment of the notes and obligations aforesaid.

(3) That the note of your Complainant in the sum of \$5,000.00, together with interest from March 12, 1937, accrued thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, still remains due and owing unto your Orator, although the due date of said note has passed and payment thereof has been duly demanded from the said Lewis H. Knock and Pauline Z. Knock, his wife.

(4) That your Complainant is reliably informed that the aforesaid note of \$15,000.00 has been assigned unto the Federal Deposit Insurance Company, a body corporate, and that it also is overdue and all accumulated interest thereon is unpaid.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That the real estate aforesaid conveyed by the said Lewis H. Knock and Pauline Z. Knock, his wife, to secure the payment of the obligations aforesaid may be decreed to be sold to pay said obligations in full, together with all accrued interest thereon.

And that your Orator may have such other and further relief as the case may require.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONORS to grant unto your Orator a writ of subpoena directed to the said Lewis H. Knock and Pauline Z. Knock, who are residents of Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, and against the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation,

among the land records of Frederick County in Liber # 406 folio 375
