TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Orpha M. Miller, Administratrix, respectfully represents:

That in the above entitled cause, she sold the real estate of Lewis D. Miller and wife, under a power of sale in a mortgage, to George L. Miller, deceased, to Ralph H. Bowlus and Nellie M. Bowlus, his wife, for the purchase price of twenty-eight hundred and fifty dollars.

That she has reported said sale to this Court, but the same has not yet been ratified by the Court, and said purchasers are unable to comply with the terms of sale.

That said purchasers have consented to the sale of said real estate to Everett Moser and Myrtle M. Moser, and agree that the names of said Everett Moser and Myrtle Moser, be substituted in the place of the original purchasers, as the purchasers of said real estate, and agree that the deed be made directly to said substituted purchasers, as appears from their agreement herewith filed and marked Exhibit A, to this petition.

Wherefore your petitioner prays for an order of Court substituting the names of Everett Moser and Myrtle M. Moser, in the place of said Ralph H. Bowlus and Nellie M. Bowlus, as the purchasers of the real estate mentioned in said proceedings, and for ~~xxx~~ such other relief as may be requisite.
