TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Amos A. Holter, Assignee of The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, a body corporate, Mortgagee described in the hereinafter mentioned mortgage from Daniel M. Woodward and Annie Elizabeth Woodward, his wife, to the said Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That the said Daniel M. Woodward and Annie Elizabeth Woodward, his wife, being indebted unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore in the sum of Two Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-two Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$2,492.60), executed their promissory note for the said sum of money on the 2nd day of July, 1931, payable in installments as follows: One Hundred Ninety-two Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$192.60) payable July 2, 1933; Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) payable July 2, 1934; Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) payable July 2, 1935; Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) payable July 2, 1936; Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) payable July 2, 1937; Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) payable July 2, 1938, and Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) payable July 2, 1939; each of said installments carrying interest separately at the rate of six per centum per annum from the date hereof, which said interest is payable annually, which said payments are more fully explained by reference to the mortgage note filed herewith marked Exhibit "A" and which is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof; and for the purpose of better securing the payment of said promissory note, the said Daniel M. Woodward and Annie Elizabeth Woodward, his wife, executed and delivered unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore their deed
