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died seized and possessed be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court to Thomas C. Dixon, by trustees to be appointed thereunder.

(2) That your Honorable Court will take jurisdiction in the premises and construe the true legal meaning of the residuary clause of the Last Will and Testament of the said Regina C. Grinder, deceased, as set forth in the sixth paragraph of this Bill of Complaint.

(3) That your Honorable Court will decree as to the investment and division of the proceeds of said sale among the parties entitled thereto, according to their respective interests.

(4) That your Petitioner may have such further and other relief as the nature of his case may require.

And your Petitioner prays for the following process: That the writ of subpoena issue in the usual form, for the purpose of summoning into Court Viola Knill, who resides in the County of Howard, State of Maryland, and to the Most Reverend Michael J. Curley, Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore and his successors, a corporation sole, who resides in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
