

(1) To William Hayes of East Liverpool, Ohio, the sum of One Hundred dollars upon the condition that he be living at the time of this distribution, but if he be then dead, this legacy shall sink into the residuum of my estate.

(2) To my grand-niece Regina Knill the sum of One Thousand Dollars upon the condition that she be living at the time of this distribution, but if she be then dead, this legacy shall sink into the residuum of my estate.

(3) To the Pastor of St. Joseph's Catholic Church on the Manor, in said Frederick County, and to his successors in office, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, the income from which shall be applied to the perpetual care, keeping in good order and condition and making repairs to the graveyard connected with said Church, in which the members of our family are buried, and if the whole of said income shall not be required for said purpose, the balance of said income shall be applied to the expenses of said Church.

(4) To Charles B. Staley, George C. Crum and Joseph McDevitt, Trustees of St. John's Council No. 1622, Knights of Columbus, and their successors in office, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars for the use of said Council.

(5) After the payment of the foregoing legacies and the collateral inheritance taxes thereon, I give and bequeath the balance of said rest and residue of my estate to my niece Viola Knill and the said Marie Murphy in equal portions during their joint lives and after the death of either of them to the survivor of them during her lifetime, and upon the death of the survivor of them, then to the Most Rev. Michael J. Curley, Roman Catholic Archbishop of Baltimore, and his successors, a corporation sole, to be paid by said corporation sole to the Pastor for the time being of the St. John's Catholic Church of Frederick, Maryland, to the Notre Dame Academy of said City and to the Academy of Visitation of said City, equally, share and share alike.

And it is further my will that in case any person or persons to whom any legacy or devise, or to whom any benefit from or by reason of my said will shall come, shall commence any suit or proceeding or file any caveat against this my last will, then my will is that all and every legacy, devise or benefit accruing to any such person hereunder shall cease and become void; and every such legacy, devise or benefit I give to the afore-
