

ORDER OF COURT

The foregoing Bill of Complaint and Affidavit having been presented to the Court, and by the Court read and considered, it is thereupon this 26 day of July, 1961, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ORDERED that the Complainant, by causing a copy of this Order to be inserted in some newspaper published in said Frederick County, once a week in each of four successive weeks, the last of such publications to be made not less than thirty days before the 3rd day of October, 1961, give notice to the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Frank Nichols, deceased, whether residents or non-residents, of the object and substance of this Bill, warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before the 3rd day of October, 1961, next, to show cause, if any they have, why a Decree ought not to be passed as prayed.
