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TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Clara E. Lewis, widow of the late
David O. Lewis, respectfully represents:

1. That she is the surviving widow and the complainant
in the above entitled cause.

passed in the above entitled cause appointing Samuel A. Lewis
