BILL OF COMPLAINT

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Carrie V. Kanode, widow, respectfully shows unto your Honors.

FIRST: That David E. Kanode, late of Frederick County, Maryland, departed this life on or about December 27, 1960, seized and possessed of all that lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being on the east side of Adam Street in the Town of Adamstown in Buckeystown Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, said lot being designated as Lot No. 4 on a Plat of Jacob Kline's Addition to Adamstown, dated June 1, 1903, and recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 17, folio 290, one of the Land Records of Frederick County; the said lot fronting 60 feet more or less on the east side of Adam Street, aforesaid, and running back a uniform width for depth 170 feet, more or less, to the west side of a 20-foot alley, which was conveyed unto David E. Kanode and Manzella Y. Kanode, his wife (the said Manzella Y. Kanode having predeceased the said David E. Kanode, and the said David E. Kanode having intermarried with Carrie V. Kanode) by Benjamin F. Bowings, and his wife, by deed dated the 10th day of May, 1948, and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber 472 folio
