TO THE END, THEREFORE:

- a) That this Court may appoint your Petitioner as Guardian for the infant herein.
- b) That this Court may authorize the purchase of Towson Welding Service and the borrowing of the necessary funds for said purchase as prayed.
- c) And for such other and further relief as your Petitioner's cause may require.
