To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:-

That by virtue of their appointment as trustees in the above cause your trustees attended on the 14th day of March 1910, in front of the Citizens Savings Bank, in Thurmont, Maryland and offered the hereinafter described parcel of land, but withdrew the same as will appear by reference to a former report to your Honorable Court.

That afterwards, to wit, ^{on the day.} your trustees again advertised said property and premises, hereinafter described by giving the usual and required notice in the Catocin Clarion, a newspapers published in Frederick County, and again your trustees failed to get a bid of over Fifteen Hundred dollars, and withdrew said sale as they believed that said price was not an adequate one, and again your trustees advertised said property and premises in the Catocin Clarion a newspaper published in Frederick County for three successive weeks and also by had bills extensively circulated in the neighbourhood of the premises, and your trustees did attend in front of the Citizens Savings Bank, in Thurmont, Maryland, on Saturday March 18th 1911, at the hour of 3.30 o'clock p.m. being the hour and the place named in said advertisement as will appear by the printers certificate herewith filed and then and there proceeded to sell all that piece or parcel of land of which Frank Hesson died seized and possessed, and which was decreed to be sold, said property having been conveyed unto said Frank Hesson by deed from Thomas E. Lycett, and situated on Lombard street in Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland, and sold the said property to The Citizens Savings Bank of Thurmont, Maryland/it being the highest and best bidder therefor, at and for the sum of Fifteen Hundred and ten dollars \$1510.- and took the acknowledgement of purchase for the same which is filed herewith as a part of this report and marked Exhibit "C.S.B."
