It is therefore this 3rd day of March, 1914, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said inquisition be, and the same is, hereby ratified and confirmed.

And it is hereby further ORDERED that William H. Hiltner and Charles A. Dix be and they are hereby appointed committee of the person and estate of the said Georgeanna Frust with full power and authority to take charge of and manage the property and assure the control of the person of the said Georgeanna Frust under the direction of this Court; but before the said William H. Dix shall proceed to act as such committee they shall give bond unto the State of Maryland, in the sum of \$ 3000.00 with sureties to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, for the faithful discharge of their duty as such committee.
