TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of B. Ella Lakin, of Frederick County, Maryland, respectfully shows:

1. That your petitioner on the 7th day of December, 1925, entered into a trust agreement with the Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, hereinafter called Trustee, which said trust agreement is herewith filed and prayed to be taken and considered as a part hereof.

2. That on the 3rd day of September, 1931, your Honorable Court, in No. 12,299 Equity, appointed George W. Page, Bank Commissioner for the State of Maryland, as Receiver for the Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate, as by reference to said proceedings will more fully appear.

3. That the Central Trust Company of Maryland, being now in the hands of Receiver in the aforesaid proceedings, is unable to continue to act as Trustee under the aforesaid trust agreement, and it is necessary that another trustee be appointed as the successor of the Central Trust Company of Maryland.

4. That the Farmers and Mechanics National Bank, a body corporate, Frederick, Maryland, has signified its willingness to act as such Trustee in the place and stead of the Central Trust Company of Maryland.

WHEREFORE your petitioner prays your Honorable Court,

1. That it may assume cognizance of said trust.
