The answer of George W. Page, Receiver of the Central Trust Company of Maryland, to the petition of B. Ella Lakin, filed in this cause:

This respondent answering, answers and says:

First: That he admits the allegations of the first and second paragraphs of the said petition.

Second: Answering the third paragraph of said petition this respondent says that the assets and property of the Central Trust Company of Maryland, are in his hands as Receiver; that said Trust Company has ceased its operations and this respondent believes it is necessary and desirable that another trustee be appointed in place of the Central Trust Company of Maryland in the matter of the trust referred to in the petition.

Third: That under the provisions of the trust deed referred to in said petition the Central Trust Company of Maryland has an interest in the corpus of the trust for the payment of certain notes held by it, and there is now in the hands of this respondent as Receiver, notes of William C. Lakin, Mary E. Lakin and B. Ella Lakin, as joint and several makers, aggregating the sum of about \$2,800.00, which, your respondent is advised and believes, are renewal notes for the notes described in the said deed of trust and for interest that has accumulated and remains unpaid.

Fourth: This respondent further says that from the records of the Central Trust Company now in his hands, the corpus of the trust consists of the following:
